This is Peter Armstrong's obituary.

It was taken from a Speedy and Gail Stewart's files. They are the family that did the cemetery book that is on line for Doniphan County, KS. Their house burned a few years ago but luckily we had made copies of their files. I bet the obituary came from the Kansas Chief but I am not sure.

Armstrong

Peter Richard Armstrong was born June 27 at Brooklyn, NY and died at a hospital in Manning, Iowa April 17, 1916, of blood poisoning, which followed injuries received two or three weeks earlier, when a team he was driving to a disk harrow ran away, pulling the harrow onto him and cutting him badly.

The family moved from Troy about two years ago to a farm near Manning. His only brother, Martin Armstrong of Chicago, was with him at the last. Funeral services were held at the Troy Christian church, yesterday forenoon, and interment was in the Fanning cemetery. His wife and three children survive, Mrs. Lena Matthews, Wathena; James Leslie Armstrong and Miss Beulah Armstrong of Troy.

When I checked the 1900 Census for Doniphan County it had Peter and Martha along with Lena and James Leslie but it also had a brother William listed with them.

While looking in the file I also found a William Armstrong. It was also taken from Speedy and Gail's file.

Wm. Armstrong died of pneumonia at P. A. Petis' (can't read it well) home about ten miles southeast of Troy Tuesday. He was a healthy man but caught cold which resulted in pneumonia.

Wm. Armstrong died at the home of his brother, Peter Armstrong, near Fanning, Sunday morning. Mr. Armstrong came from New York four years ago. He was a victim of consumption. The funeral was held Monday.

I also found a listing for a Elizabeth Armstrong. It listed the day but not the year (May 6). It was also taken from Speedy and Gail Stewart's file.

Mrs Elizabeth Armstrong died at the home of her son, Louis M. Armstrong, at 805 North 22nd street ST. Joseph, at 8:30 p.m., May 6.

Mrs Armstrong was 84 years old Jan 17. She was the widow of William Armstrong. Funeral Services were held at 2:30 Thursday at the first baptist Church the Rev. F.E. Carter, pastor, officiating. Burial was at Belmont cemetery, A. L. Dodds, of Meierhoffer Mortuary in charge.
