I did find a reference to a Nelson S. Babcock in a book called "Doniphan County's Illustrated History". It goes as far as 1913. It said something about shipping apples, but that was all it said. I could find no mention of the name Asche. I also did not find anything pertaining to a Lina or Magdalena Babcock, but did find a paragraph about Mrs. Nelson S. Babcock, stating that her name was Mae. I wonder if that could be short for Magdalena?

It said she was a school teacher. It has photos of her with her students. I did not want to copy anything until I was sure this is who you were looking for. Was the "Lina" you are looking for a school teacher?
