I am presently researching American Service Members that were casualties of the Vietnam War. Perhaps you could put me in touch with someone that could research your newspaper archives for articles that that appeared in your newspaper for:

<u>Bell, Charles Martin</u>, Wathena, the date of his casualty was on Jan 3, 1968. <u>Gladden, James Taylor Jr</u>, Wathena, the date of his casualty was on Jun 12, 1970.

Normally I have found that most articles on the deaths appear within a few days to four weeks after the date of the casualty. What I am seeking is articles on his death as reported in your local newspaper along with his obituary and any follow-up articles that may have been published.

I am seeking a photo (preferably in uniform) as well. By obtaining news articles we will then attempt to contact family members to obtain a photo. Perhaps if you know family members you might forward this letter on to them. Please notify me of any charges and I will get payment sent in the mail.

Our organization is trying to compile records with photo's of all our Kansas Brothers that gave their lives during the Vietnam War for current and future generations to reflect upon their loss. The purpose of this is that I have found that by putting a "photo" or a "face to a name" it has a dramatic input on people when they can see these men were no different then today's youth and defending our constitutional right for freedom. A photo says so much more then just reading a written name. We use these photo's and articles during visits to Kansas schools, Vietnam Awareness Memorials and anywhere we can do honor to these men.


