### Moran to Address **HCC's Graduates** Friday, May 14

Plans have been finalized for the 2010 commencement exercises at Highland Community College. The 2010 commencement will again be held outdoors on Friday evening, May 14, at 7:00 pm on Kessinger Field on the HCC campus. Over 150 graduates are scheduled to hear the Honorable Jerry Moran, Kansas U.S. Congressman, who will be the guest speaker.

The HCC Commencement will be broadcast live by accessing the College's Web site at www.highlandcc.edu. There will be a rotating slide on the Homepage that will provide viewers with instructions.
