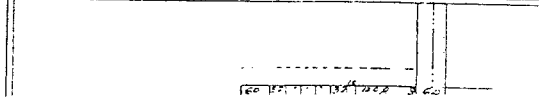


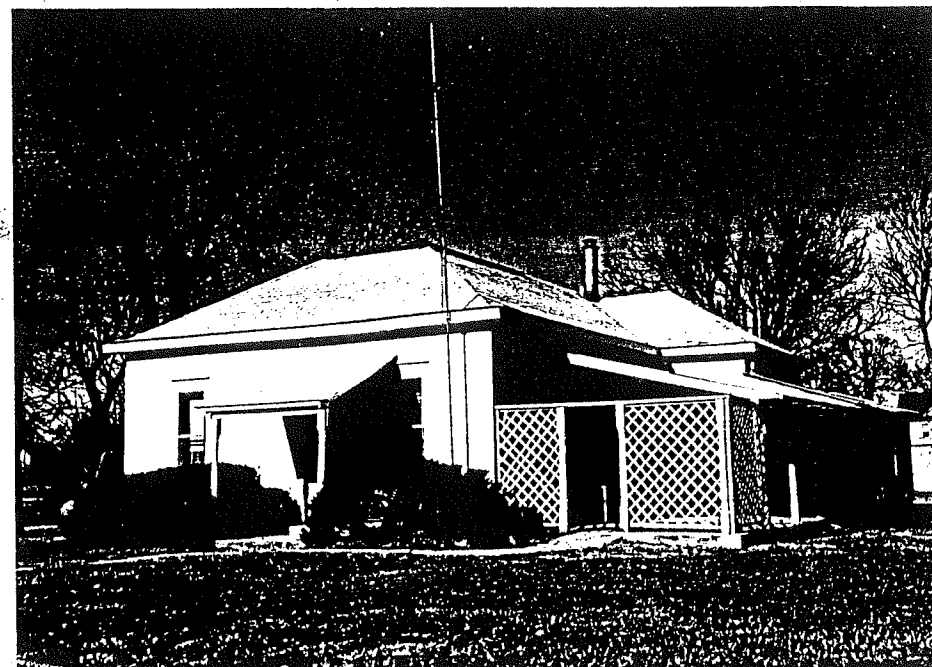
### Straight Creek
